Inflation Impacts:

The primary impacts of inflation include the following:

- SSI foster care rate is adjusted based on COLA of 2.5% for 2025.
- Changes in lease agreements in field offices and Helena with additional cost escalators.
- Cost increases in longstanding contracts. For example, technology contracts M&O increases for existing systems.

DPHHS 2025 Annual Plan:

CFSD is included in Strategic Outcome #2.

Key Measure:

Increase measurable skill growth for foster youth engaging in vocational rehabilitation services for 25% of all participants.

On July 1, 2023, 33 Foster Care Youth received VR services, and on June 30, 2024, 69 received VR services.

Continued efforts to submit referrals for foster youth aged 14 to 18 are being used to identify foster youth eligible for pre-ETS.

CFSD has a five-year plan with annual updates as a requirement under the Administration for Children and Families. <u>2020 - 2024 Five Year Plan (CFSP)</u>

Efficiencies and Cost Savings:

CFSD is focusing on improving timeliness to permanency for youth in foster care. CFSD is above the national average on two of the three federal measurements.

CFSD is focused on improving the timeliness of children in foster care greater than 24 + months.
