

## TARGETED CASE MANAGEMENT (TCM) NON-MENTAL HEALTH – HIGH-RISK PREGNANT WOMEN (HRPW)

### TCM – High-Risk Pregnant Women:

The Targeted Case Management High-Risk Pregnant Women (TCM-HRPW) Program assists pregnant women in obtaining access to needed medical, social, or other resources and services by establishing and maintaining a referral process for necessary and appropriate services and avoiding duplication of services.

### Access:

In Montana, there are eight TCM-HRPW participating providers.

### Utilization:

- In SFY 2024, 20 pregnant women received TCM-HRPW services.
- In SFY 2024, \$819 was reimbursed for TCM-HRPW services.

### Reimbursement:

TCM-HRPW services are paid fee-for-service.

### Services:

Reimbursable targeted case management services for high-risk pregnant women include:

- Comprehensive assessment and periodic reassessment,
- Care plan development,
- Care coordination and referral for other services, and
- Monitoring and follow-up.

### Requirements:

Face-to-face comprehensive assessments must occur at least monthly during the pregnancy. Two post-partum reassessments must occur after the end of the pregnancy.



Monitoring must include at least once annually to determine if the following conditions are met:

- Services are being furnished under the member's care plan,
- Services in the care plan are adequate, and
- Changes in the needs or status of the member are reflected in the care plan.

**Providers:**

TCM-HRPW providers must use an interdisciplinary team that includes professional nurses, social workers, and nutritionists.
