Montana accepts the Section 1115 Montana Healing and Ending Addiction through Recovery and Treatment (HEART) Demonstration (Project Number 11-W-00395/8) Special Terms and Conditions as presented in the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) letter dated July 1, 2022.

Under this demonstration, Montana Medicaid will be able to provide state plan services to otherwise-eligible Medicaid beneficiaries, ages 18 to 64, who are primarily receiving treatment and withdrawal management services for Substance Use Disorder (SUD) while residing in residential and inpatient settings that qualify as institutions for mental diseases (IMD).
