Substance Abuse and Mental Health Resource

Substance abuse is when the recurrent use of alcohol and/or drugs causes clinically and functionally significant impairment, such as health problems, disability, and failure to meet major responsibilities at work, school, or home. Substance abuse is a patterned use of a drug in which the user consumes the substance in amounts or with methods which are harmful to themselves or others, and is a form of substance related disorder.

Drugs most often associated with this term include: alcohol, tobacco, cannabis, substituted amphetamines, barbiturates, benzodiazepines, cocaine, methaqualone, and opioids.

In 2013, 9.4% of the population had used an illicit drug in the past month. This number is up from 8.3% in 2002 (National Institute on Drug Abuse).

In 2013, 17.3 million (6.6% of the population) Americans were dependent on alcohol or had problems related to their alcohol use (National Institute on Drug Abuse).

Many people who are addicted to drugs are also diagnosed with other mental disorders, including anxiety and depression. Some people develop mental health problems related to their compulsive drug use, and some people take drugs in an attempt to alleviate symptoms of mental health disorders (National Institute on Drug Abuse).
