Breastfeeding Promotion and Support

The Montana CACFP strongly supports the breastfeeding of infants.

For CACFP-participating institutions licensed or approved to care for infants, the State agency staff will provide, if asked: technical assistance to plan, provide and maintain best practices to accommodate breastfeeding of enrolled infants.

For all CACFP-participating institutions licensed or approved to care for infants, the institution must provide space that promotes and supports breastfeeding. The space must include:

- 1. Provides information that states the institution support of the breastfeeding of infants.
- 2. Designates a private place for a breastfeeding mother to nurse her infant or to express her milk.
- 3. Provides access to water, a sink and refrigeration for the storage of breastmilk.
- 4. Information that describes the safe handling of breastmilk at the institution.
