Most Common Errors Found During CACFP Reviews

Listed below are some of the most common errors we find during the reviews we perform each year. A reviewer may discover some of these errors during a review or may find errors not listed here. Please keep in mind that this list is not inclusive of all possible errors. - 1. Menu not posted, whole grains indicated, and non-creditable foods posted on menu.
- 2. Income Eligibility Meal Benefit Forms contain errors.
- 3. Center staff training not completed or not documented.
- 4. Meals not served family style.
- 5. Monthly Attendance/Sing-in and Out Records contains errors.
- 6. Insufficient milk purchased for meals claimed.
- 7. For non-profit centers, CACFP oversight not mentioned in board minutes.
- 8. Documentation for Special Dietary needs is incomplete or not available.
- 9. Food purchase receipts not separated from non-foodservice purchases.
- 10. Refrigerator and freezer thermometers are not available.
- 11. Supervisory visits for institutions with multiple facilities have not been completed.
- 12. Non-discriminatory statement not included in parent handbook.
