

ACA/FAMILY MEDICAID 1001 Subsidized Adoption Overview

Supersedes: FMA 1100 & FMA 1101-1 (07/01/06)

Reference: 42 CFR 435.145, .222(b)(2), .227, .308(b)(2); ARM 37.82.101, and .701

Overview: Children eligible for IV-E or non-IV-E adoption subsidies are automatically eligible for Subsidized Adoption Medicaid. **NOTE:** Subsidized adoption cases are not used for any program other than subsidized adoption. If the family applies for other coverage, a new case may need to be opened if one doesn't already exist.

PROCESSING:

Policy Bureau in HCSD central office maintains the subsidized adoption caseload.

CHILD & FAMILY SERVICES:

Child and Family Services Division in Helena determines subsidized adoption Medicaid eligibility. Families moving into Montana who have questions about subsidized adoption are referred to:
