# The Montana HELP Plan is open for enrollment!

For many Montanans who have been previously ineligible for affordable health coverage, there is a new affordable option: Medicaid expansion and the Montana HELP Plan. The Montana HELP Plan is an affordable health insurance plan for low-income Montanans. **You can sign up now for coverage that will start in January 2016!**

**To be eligible for Medicaid expansion or the Montana HELP Plan you must meet the following:**

- Montana residents who meet the income guidelines
- Ages 19-64
- Not already enrolled in or able to get Medicare

## What does the HELP Plan cover?

- Doctor, hospital, and emergency services
- Prescription drugs
- Dental and vision care
- Laboratory and x-ray services
- Maternity and newborn care
- Mental health and substance abuse treatment
- Rehabilitative services and supplies
- Transportation to appointments

**You are likely eligible for the Montana HELP Plan if your annual income is:**



Single: less than \$16,243  
Family of 2: less than \$21,983  
Family of 3: less than \$27,724  
Family of 4: less than \$33,465  
Family of 5: less than \$39,206



## American Indians and Medicaid Expansion

- American Indians qualify for expansion coverage under Montana Medicaid and are not subject to any premiums or copays.
- To qualify for this provisions, you must indicate that you are American Indian on the application. If you missed this on the application, don't worry because you can update your application at any point so that it reflects that you are of American Indian descent.

## Apply now in any of the following ways:

- **Meet with a local enrollment assister.** With just your zip code, [find a list of enrollment assisters who can answer your questions and walk you through the application process.](#) Their help is always free and confidential.
- You enroll on your own at [www.HealthCare.gov](http://www.HealthCare.gov) or over the phone 1-800-318-2596.
- You can also enroll at your local [Office of Public Assistance.](#)
