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## Montana Medicaid State Plan Amendments and Waiver Changes effective July 1, 2022

On or before June 30, 2022, the Montana Department of Public Health and Human Services (DPHHS) is submitting the following Medicaid State Plan Amendments, effective July 1, 2022.

The Targeted Case Management Services for Individuals with Developmental Disabilities Enrolled in the 0208 1915(c) Waiver or Eligible Individuals Age 16 and Over State Plan is being added to the reimbursement Introduction Page. This change will have no fiscal impact.

A sentence with the effective date of the fee schedule rate is being added to the Licensed Marriage & Family Therapists reimbursement pages. This change will have no fiscal impact.

Although DPHHS is not required to submit Medicaid 1915(c) Home and Community Based Services (HCBS) Waiver amendments to CMS for rate increases under 10%, the state wants to inform the public that the following HCBS services are receiving the following rate increases:

## • Big Sky Waiver

All Big Sky Waiver services are receiving an approximate .3% rate increase except:

- o Transportation Mileage
- Adult Group Homes
- o Adult Foster Care
- Level 1 Assisted Living
- o Level 2 Assisted Living Behavior Management (a new service)
- Level 3 Specialized Assisted Living
- <u>Comprehensive Waiver for Individuals with Developmental Disabilities (DD)</u>
  All Comprehensive DD Waiver services are receiving an approximate 1.9% rate increase except:
  - Individual Goods and Services
  - o Remote Monitoring Equipment
  - Specialized Medical Equipment & Supplies
  - o Environmental Modifications
  - o Personal Emergency Response System
  - o Community Transition Services
