Summary of Administrative Rules of Montana (ARM) Changes Adopted July 27, 2024

37.114.101 Definitions

Definition added:

- “Institutional and congregate settings” include, but are not limited to: facilities that serve unrelated people who live in close proximity and share at least one common room (e.g., group or personal care homes, assisted living facilities, jails); facilities that serve unrelated people who attend or congregate in close proximity and share at least one common room (e.g., daycare, school); or healthcare facilities as defined in 50-5-101, MCA.

37.114.203 Reportable Diseases and Other Conditions of Public Health Importance

Conditions added:

- Acute flaccid myelitis (AFM);
- Carbapenemase-producing carbapenem-resistant organisms (CP-CRO);
- *Cronobacter* in infants;
- Group A *Streptococcus*, invasive disease; and
- Multisystem inflammatory syndrome in children (MIS-C).

Conditions updated:

- Anaplasmosis, ehrlichiosis, and spotted fever rickettsiosis, which were previously listed separately, have been deleted and relisted together as:
 - Rickettsial diseases (including spotted fevers, flea-borne typhus, scrub typhus, anaplasmosis, and ehrlichiosis).
- Monkeypox has been relisted as mpox.
