


Recalls of products may be for bacterial contamination, undeclared allergens, or physical contaminants, such as pieces of plastic. Significant or serious risks to the consumer or user of the product can be prevented when recalls are initiated.



# ALERT LEVEL

Alert Level

Determines what kind of action should be taken by local environmental health offices. The top alert level means there is an illness or high risk of illness in Montana associated with it.



#### NOTIFICATION

FCS sends an e-mail to all local environmental health offices with the recall information, distribution and alert level.

### **ACTION**

Action from the local environmental health office may include contacting local facilities to make sure the product has been removed from shelves, notifying facilities that may have received the product, and supplying information to the public.
