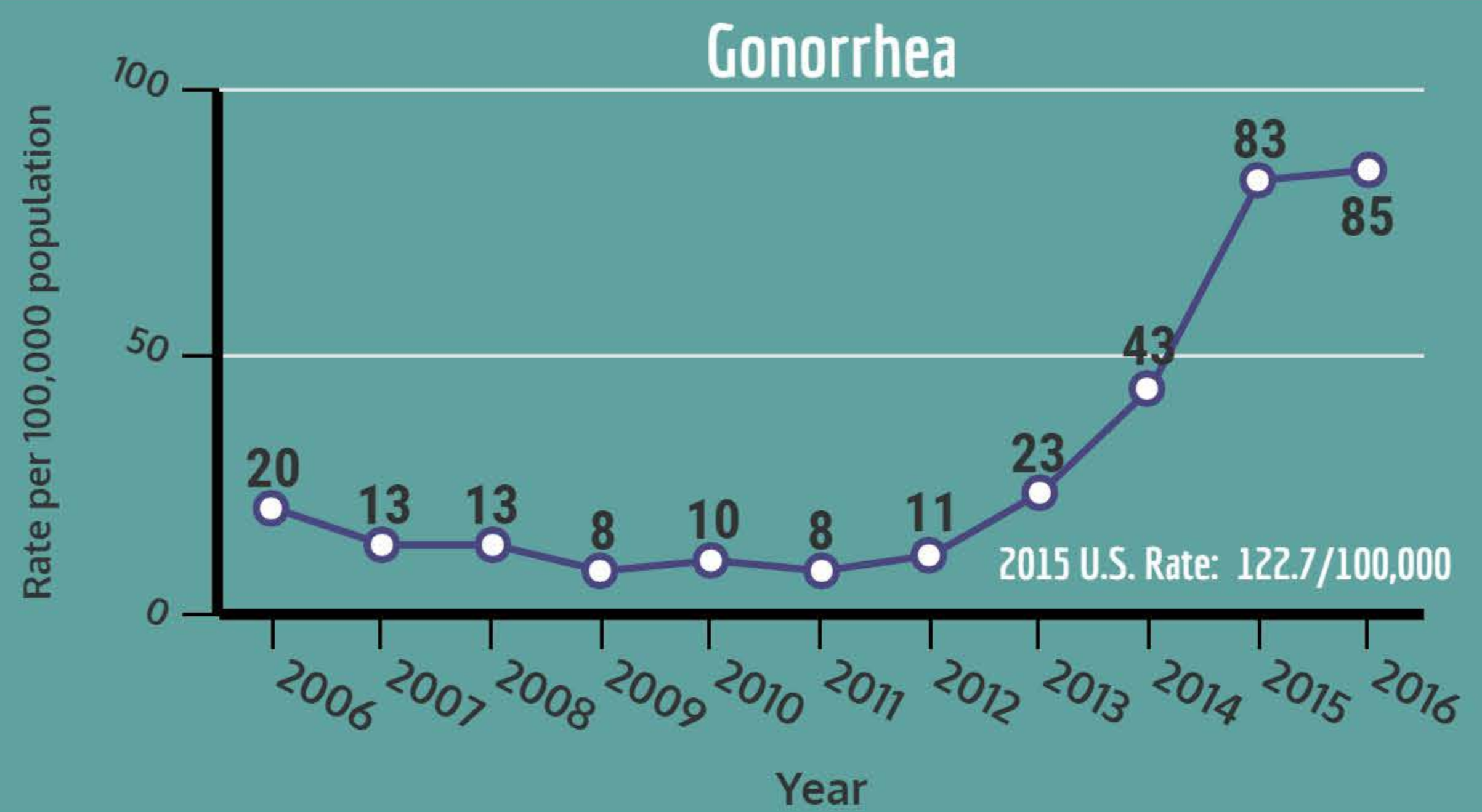
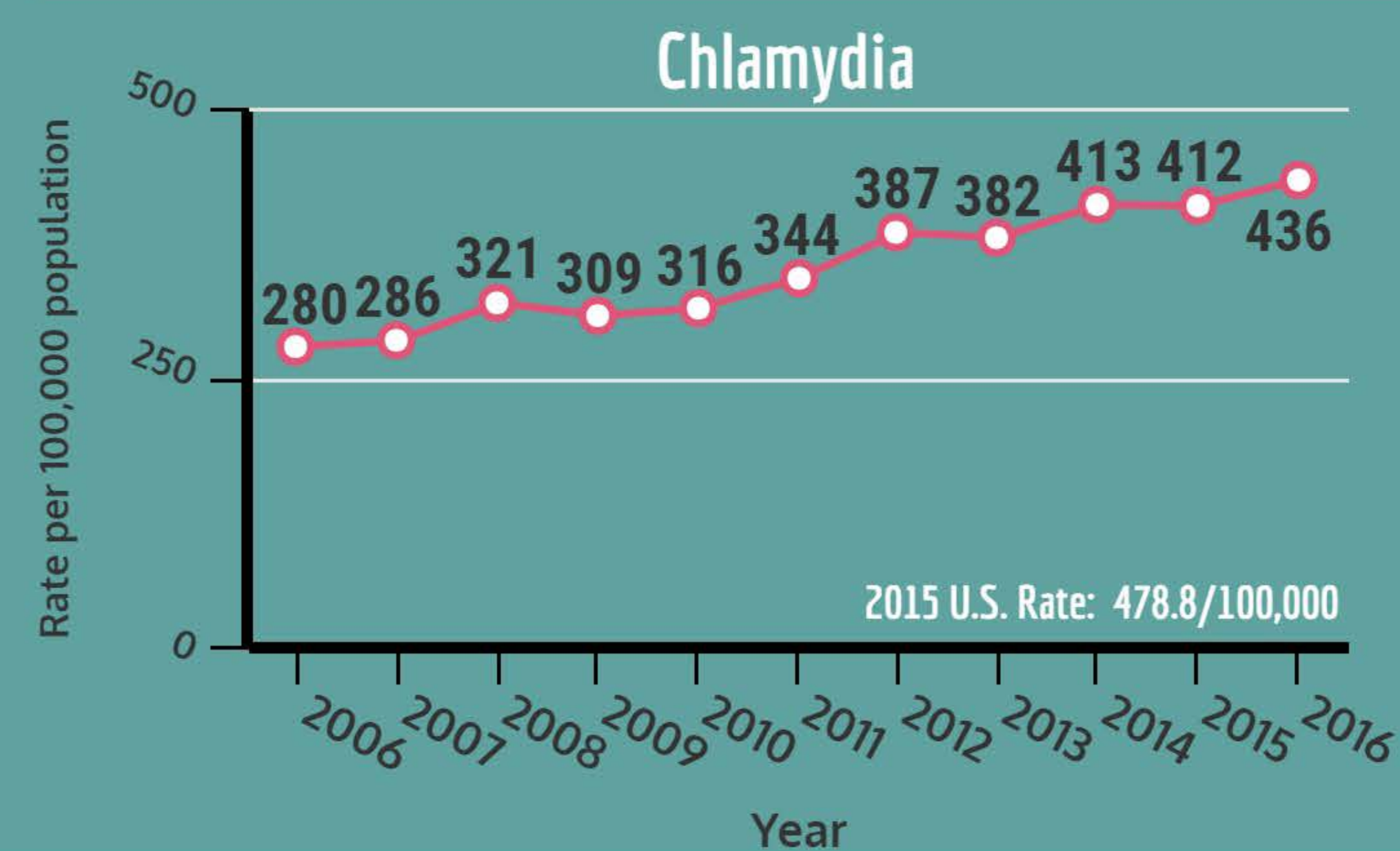

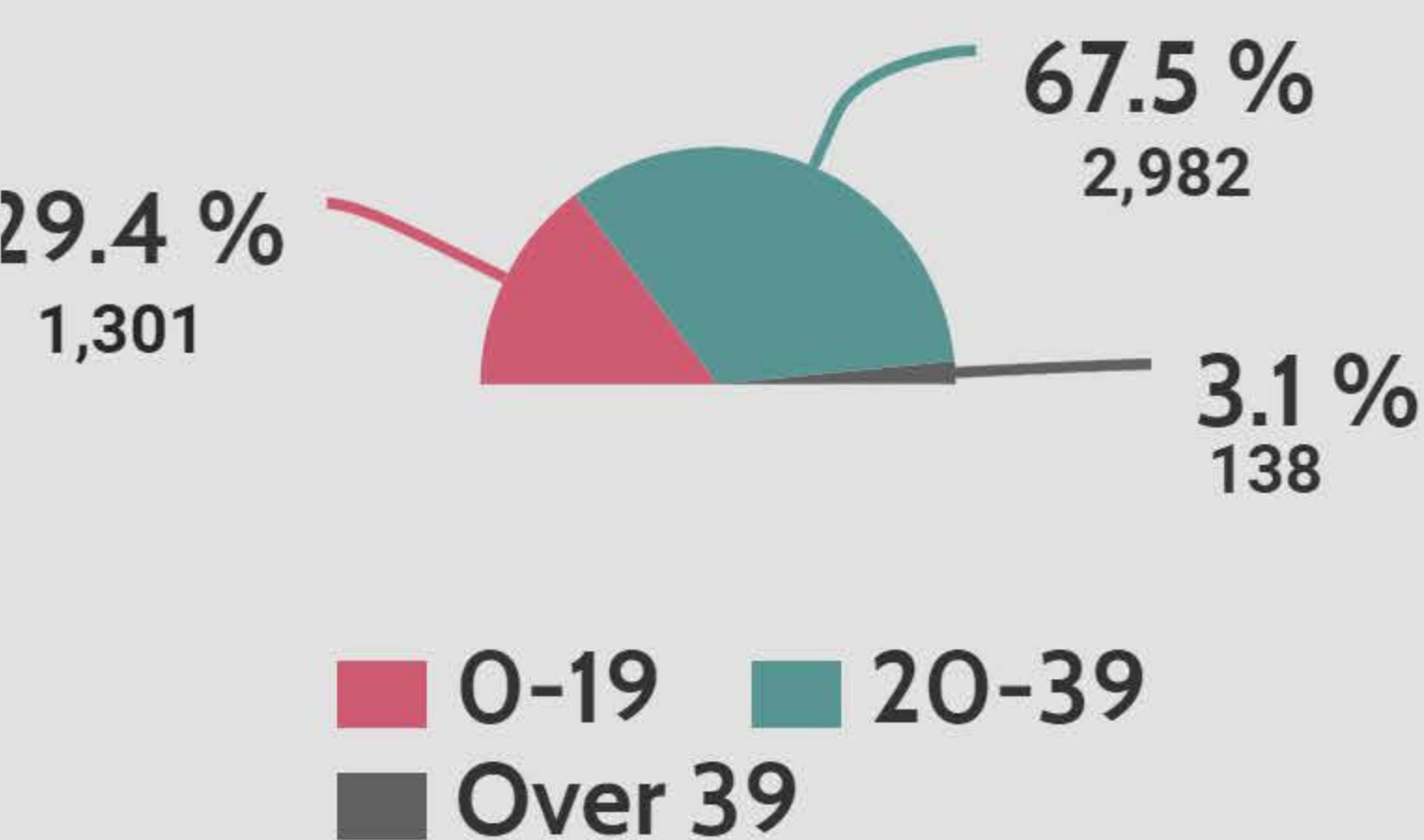

In 2016, 14 primary and secondary cases of syphilis were reported compared to 13 in 2015.

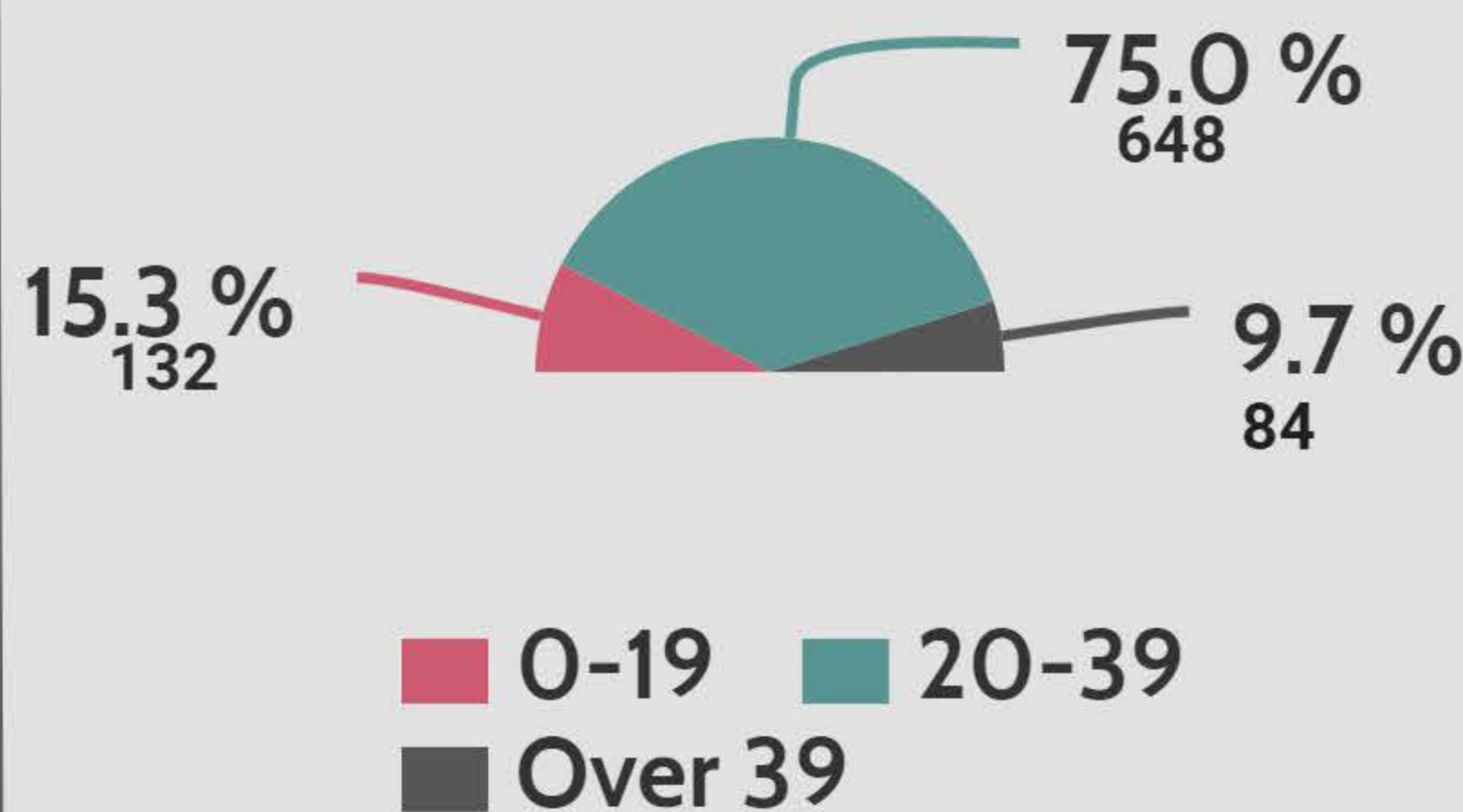
