

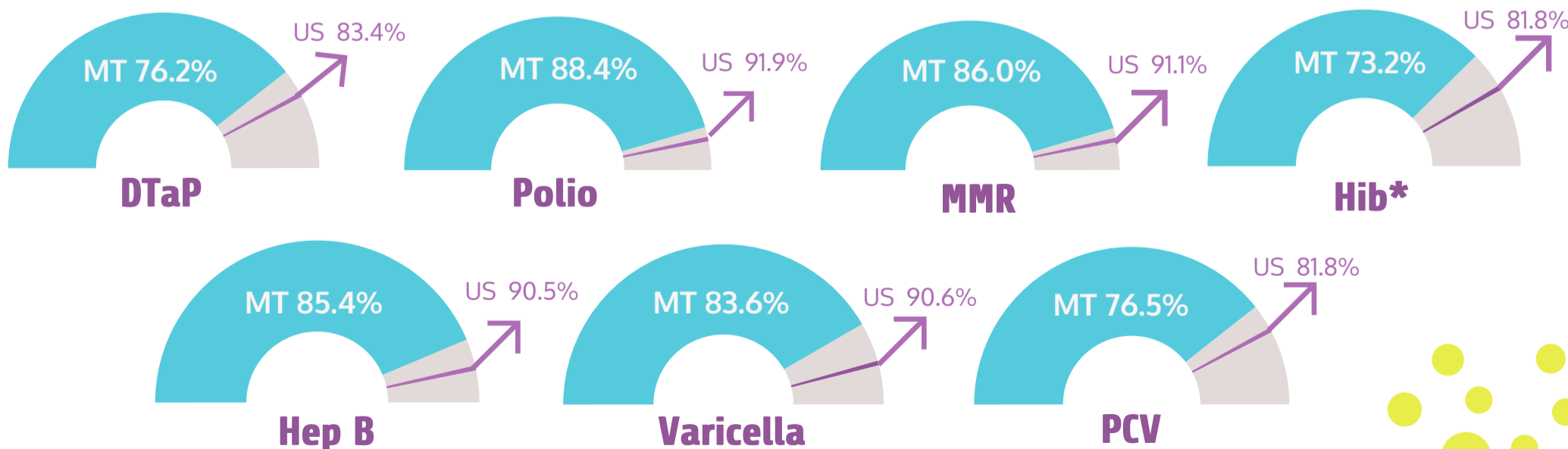
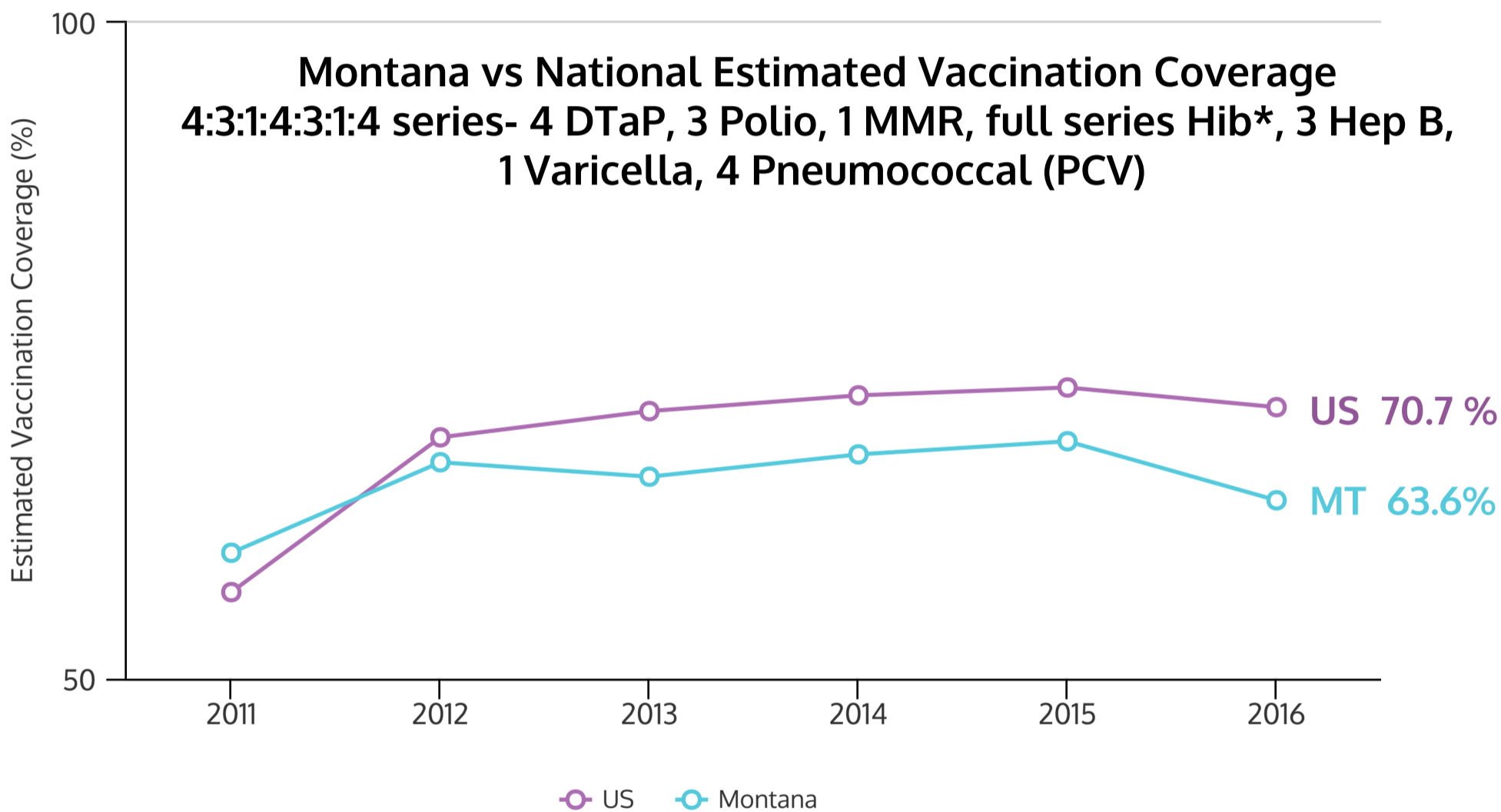
# Montana Immunization Coverage Estimates

Montana's childhood immunization rates continue to be below the national average. Healthcare providers can help to improve immunization coverage rates by assessing immunization status of their patients at every visit and through use of reminder/recall systems. Parents/guardians can also monitor their child's immunization status and work with healthcare providers to ensure every child is protected by being up-to-date on important immunizations.

The NIS is a list-assisted random-digit-dialing telephone survey followed by a mailed survey to children's immunization providers that began data collection in April 1994 to monitor childhood immunization coverage.
