




## Prevention of Disease Outbreaks in School Settings



- 442 Pertussis cases have been reported in 22 Montana counties so far in 2019.
- Missoula County experienced a large school-based pertussis outbreak starting in April of 2019. As of August 22, 2019, Missoula County has reported 165 cases of pertussis.



According to CDC, illness in schools can be prevented by the following:

- 1. Students and staff should stay up to date with all immunizations including influenza.
- 2. Help stop the spread of germs by covering your cough, staying home when you are sick per school policy, and washing your hands.
- 3. Routinely disinfect surfaces and objects that are touched often, such as desks, countertops, doorknobs, keyboards, faucets, and phones.
