- MT 2021 Cardiac Arrest Survival Rate Increased 3% over 2020
- There have been 8 Saves in First Quarter 2022
- Officers are Doing Good CPR

- Plan for Pad/Battery Replacement 2024-25
- Develop SOPs for Devices

Dispatch

Increase/Improve Telephone-CPR



- Not Available in all Areas
- Training Free from EMSTS
- Every 1 Minute Delay in CPR = 10% Decrease in Survival
