### State Opioid Response (SOR)

The State Opioid Response (SOR) III aims to reduce the number of opioid and stimulant related overdose deaths and improve health outcomes for individuals with opioid and stimulant use disorders in Montana.

#### SOR III Goals:

- Increase Access to Prevention Services
- Strengthen Harm Reduction Strategies
- Increase Access to Recovery Services
- Increase Access to Treatment for Underserved Populations


In order to support the SOR III goals, MTPHI will develop, implement, and fund 6 regional Opioid Education and Naloxone Distribution Programs (OENDP) pilot sites across Montana.


### **OENDP** Goals

MTPHI will serve as the clearing house for OENDP resources.

The goal of the OENDP is a regional effort to increase access to training for and distribution of naloxone within each region and to connect communities to resources, with the goal of reducing health disparities related to opioid misuse.
