Children are especially vulnerable to the harmful effects of lead.



- Bring up to five bags of soil in separate clean and clear quart-sized plastic bags. Plastic bags should be at least half full of soil.
- Be sure the soil is dry and free of debris and plant material.
  - $\circ\;$  Scan the QR code for an instructional video on collecting soil
- State health department staff will screen your soil, provide results, and answer questions.
- Teton County Health Department will offer free capillary testing for lead for children ages 6 and under.
