These awards are presented for achievement in immunization coverage levels based on the assessment conducted for the 2018 immunization assessment visit.

90% Award

The 90% Award is presented to clinics with at least 11 records that achieve a 90% or higher UTD coverage rate for the series. The award is based on 4 DTaP, 3 Polio, 1 MMR, UTD Hib, 3 Hepatitis B, 1 Varicella, and UTD PCV series.
