



## MT Eligibility for Publicly Funded Vaccines

This document provides guidance on choosing the most appropriate insurance status and coding for children and adults receiving vaccines from Montana DPHHS.

### Choosing Insurance Status and Codes for Children

Patient Status	Eligibility for Public Vaccine*	Eligibility Code & Description	Funding Code & Description
<b>Any patient under 19 with private insurance</b>	<b>No</b>	<b>V01</b> NOT VFC Eligible	<b>PHC70</b> Privately funded vaccine stock
<b>Medicaid Child</b> Child is less than 19 years old and is enrolled in Medicaid or Medicaid Managed Care.	<b>Yes</b> Federal (VFC) vaccine eligible	<b>V02</b> VFC eligible – Medicaid – Under 19	<b>VXC51</b> Publicly funded vaccine stock – VFC
<b>Uninsured Child</b> Child is less than 19 years old and does not have health insurance.	<b>Yes</b> Federal (VFC) vaccine eligible	<b>V03</b> VFC eligible – Uninsured	<b>VXC51</b> Publicly funded vaccine stock – VFC
<b>American Indian/Alaska Native Child</b> Child is less than 19 years old and is a member of a federally recognized tribe.	<b>Yes</b> Federal (VFC) vaccine eligible	<b>V04</b> VFC eligible – American Indian/Alaska Native	<b>VXC51</b> Publicly funded vaccine stock – VFC
<b>Under-insured Child seen at a FQHC/RHC</b> Child is less than 19 years old, is receiving care at a Federally Qualified Health Center/Rural Health Center (FQHC/RHC) and has insurance but insurance does not cover vaccines.	<b>Yes</b> Federal (VFC) vaccine eligibility only through FQHC/RHC providers	<b>V05</b> VFC eligible – Underinsured	<b>VXC51</b> Publicly funded vaccine stock – VFC



### Choosing Insurance Status and Codes for Adults

Patient Status	Eligibility for Public Vaccine	Eligibility Code & Description	Funding Code & Description
<b>Adult with Private or State Medicare Insurance</b> Adults are 19 years or older and are enrolled in private insurance plan or Medicare.	<b>No</b>	<b>V01</b> Ineligible for VFC – Private Insurance or Medicare	<b>PHC70</b> Privately funded vaccine stock
<b>Un/Under-insured Adult seen at a Facility that has 317 State Supplied Adult Vaccines</b> Adult is 19 or older, is receiving care at a facility that has 317-funded, state supplied adult vaccine and does not have insurance or has insurance, but insurance does not cover vaccines.	<b>Yes</b> State program eligible	<b>V23</b> Uninsured Adult	<b>VXC52</b> Publicly funded vaccine stock.
