

1 What is imMTrax?

imMTrax is Montana's Immunization Information System, which is a confidential computer program that can securely store immunization records for all Montanans. imMTrax combines multiple records to form one patient shot record. Healthcare providers and school personnel can access a patient's record to check immunization status. Healthcare providers can also add immunizations to a record to keep the information up-to-date.

2 Isn't my child/my immunization information already recorded by my doctor?

Yes, however, most people see more than one healthcare provider. imMTrax simplifies immunization record keeping and helps keep track of a patient's immunization status, even if they move to a new town or leave the state of Montana.

3 Does everyone have to put their information in imMTrax?

Whether you or your child participate in imMTrax is 100% up to you! Montana says that consent must be given by a parent or guardian to participate in imMTrax. Consent can also be withdrawn at any time.
