

# BSW 729 Services: Extended State Plan Service: Respiratory Therapy

## PURPOSE/DEFINITION

Respiratory therapy includes direct treatment, ongoing assessment, equipment monitoring and upkeep, pulmonary education, and rehabilitation.

## PROVIDER REQUIREMENTS

~~A Respiratory Therapist must be licensed in accordance with state regulations and enrolled as a Medicaid BSW provider through Conduent.~~

~~A member's legally responsible person, relative and/or legal guardian may provide respiratory therapy if they are licensed in accordance with state regulations and are enrolled as a Medicaid waiver provider through Conduent. Conduent verifies the provider is free of exclusions and criminal activity as part of the enrollment process.~~

## GENERAL SERVICE REQUIREMENTS

~~Any activities provided under this service must be tied to goals and objectives documented in the member's service plan.~~

## SERVICE LIMITS

This service is available only to members 21 year of age and older. Respiratory Therapy is available to members under the age of 21 as a State Plan service under the Early and Periodic Screening, Diagnosis, and Treatment (EPSDT) program.

## PROVIDER REQUIREMENTS

A Respiratory Therapist must be licensed in accordance with state regulations and enrolled as a Medicaid provider.

Individuals who are legally responsible for members may provide Respiratory Therapy if they are licensed in accordance with state regulations and are enrolled as a Medicaid provider.

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
