The Support You Need in the Setting You Deserve: In Your Home and Community

The Montana Big Sky Waiver (BSW) allows people who might otherwise need institutionalized care to live in their own homes and communities. The program supports individuals with physical disabilities and/or older adults.

Each member works with a case management team (CMT) to develop an individualized, person-centered service plan that addresses medical, social, and personal needs.

The goal of person-centered planning is to increase member choice, participation, and independence while ensuring health and safety.

Since BSW is not an entitlement program, there may be a waitlist for potential members.
