PURPOSE The scope and nature of Speech and Audiology Therapy services

furnished under Big Sky Waiver differ from those provided under State Plan as to the intent of the therapies provided. State Plan Speech and Audiology Therapy services are delivered with a focus on restorative therapy services. Speech and Audiology Therapy under Big Sky Waiver is limited to maintenance therapy services.

DEFINITIONS Restorative therapy services:

Therapy services performed with a reasonable expectation that the recipient's function will improve significantly in a reasonable and predictable period of time; refer to the Montana Medicaid Provider

manual.

Maintenance therapy services:

Therapy services that are repetitive and required to maintain functions that are performed without a reasonable expectation of

significant progress.

PROVIDER REQUIREMENTS

A Speech and Audiology Therapist must be licensed in accordance with state regulations and enrolled as a Medicaid BSW provider

through Conduent. A member's legally responsible person, relative and/or legal guardian may provide speech therapy if they are licensed in accordance with state regulations and are enrolled as a Medicaid waiver provider through Conduent. Conduent verifies the provider is free of exclusions and criminal activity as part of the

enrollment process.

GENERAL SERVICE

REQUIREMENTS Any activities provided under this service must be tied to goals and

objectives documented in the member's service plan.

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SERVICE

LIMITS Restorative Speech and Audiology Therapy services under Big Sky

Waiver may not be reimbursed and are subject to repayment.
